#### Winter Reminder

When snow is expected, street parking is not allowed during and immediately after a snowfall until the roads have been cleared.

Every year, holiday lights should be tested for safety prior to use. If you choose to purchase new lights this year, look for a label indicating that the lights were independently tested for safety. Whether they are new or old, inspect each set of lights for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections.

As a reminder: For your safety, please remember that placing lights on the second story or roof of your home is not allowed.
